PLEASE READ ALL OF THIS DOCUMENT BEFORE CALLING THE INSTRUCTOR

In most states, hunters cannot hunt legally unless they have had some type of formal education in the proper handling of firearms, as well as a basic understanding of what hunting is and means to the environment.

Today, California requires hunter education training for all persons who have not formerly held a California hunting license, or who do not have a hunter education certificate of completion from another state or province to attend, complete and pass a test to attain a Certificate. California has many 11 hour classes and they are listed on the DGF website.

The following "On-Line" courses are not meant as a beginner course, as they are based on the premise of some past hunting experience and understanding of the terms and safety principles one learns as they grow up around hunting. That is not to say we will turn anyone away, we will not. It means that those individuals that do not have exposure to hunting, or are younger will find it difficult to pass the test the first time.

California on-line course options for you;

All of these sites have an on-line course that you can run through at your own pace. You can **AS AN OPTION** take their **PRACTICE** test online that you will have to pay for. This fee supports their efforts for hunter education nationally. This test is **OPTIONAL** and will not count towards the four hour portion of the HE Certificate. If you do not complete the online material, we will quickly see the results when you take the test at the end of the 4 hour portion.

The on-line course alone will **NOT get you a valid hunter education certificate. You must complete the **4** hours as well.**

The 4 hour class consists of a:

Review the material from the on-line course(s)

Review of the California specific laws

Review of the additional safety/survival information

Review of the current hunting laws location (where do I go to get them)

100 questions test – T/F & multiple choice & 6 fill questions

Successful completion of the class and a passing grade of 80% or better on the test, you will be issued a Certificate that day and you can immediately purchase a Hunting license from a local sporting goods store.

Please do not call for special days or last minute classes – we are a volunteer organization and cannot support lack of planning issues with hunters that suddenly find they have to have a certificate today for a hunt tomorrow. We DO NOT get paid for our efforts and WILL NOT accept payment for special classes.
