

ON TARGET

Orange County's Premier 25 Yard Indoor Range

- ALL SHOOTERS AND VISITORS **MUST** WEAR EYE AND EAR PROTECTION AT ALL TIMES WHILE ON THE RANGE.
- ALL FIREARMS **MUST** BE UNLOADED, WITH ACTIONS OPEN OR IN A CASE WHEN NOT AT A SHOOTING BOOTH.
- Always keep the firearm pointed in a safe direction & keep your finger off the trigger until you are ready to shoot.
- Load and unload at shooting booth only.
- Do not bring any LOADED or JAMMED guns into the lobby. If your firearm jams, leave it at the booth, and call the range officer.
- No rapid fire is allowed... keep your shots down to no more than one per second.
- Do not throw brass in the trash. Leave brass on the floor or sweep it forward onto the range.
- Pistol targets are to be no closer than the first white line at 7 yards.
- No holstering/drawing guns unless you are Law Enforcement and using bay #1 when civilian shooters are not present (with range officer's approval).
- Only one person allowed in the firing booth while shooting.
- Open only one door at a time when entering or leaving the range. Let the door close behind you before proceeding through the next one.

VIOLATIONS OF THE SAFETY RULES WILL RESULT IN YOU BEING REQUIRED TO LEAVE THE RANGE.
